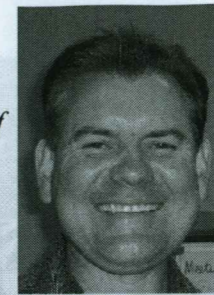

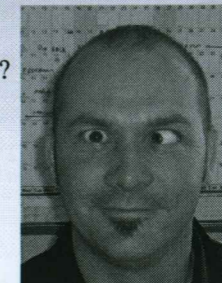

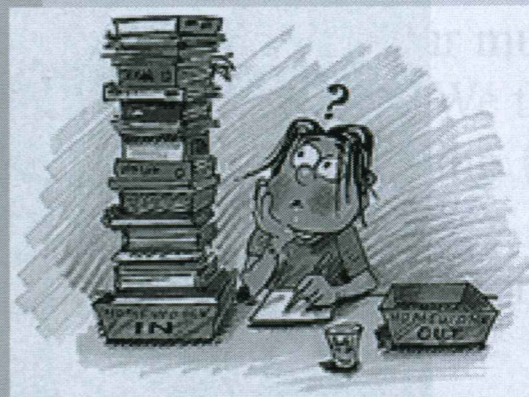
On Wednesday 30th May we held a Crazy Dress and Fun Run day. Students ran, walked and cycled to raise money for the school.

## You Can Do It! Program

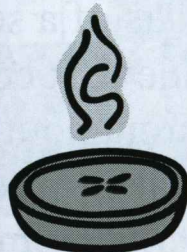

# JSC Footy Day



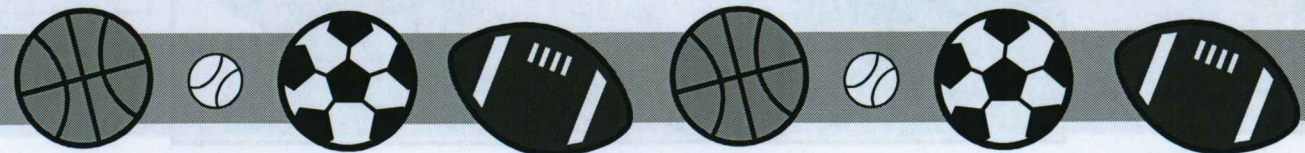
On Friday 7th of September the Lake School participated in a Footy Day to raise funds for the worthy 'Challenge' organisation who help kids with cancer.

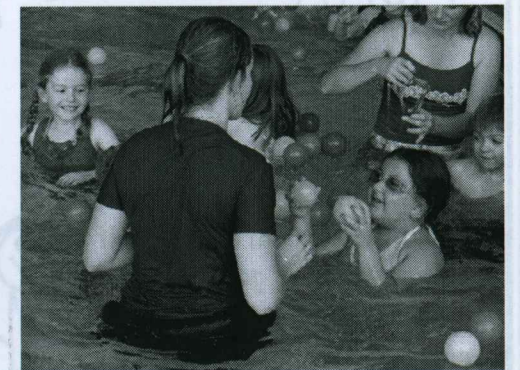
# P-2 Swimming Program

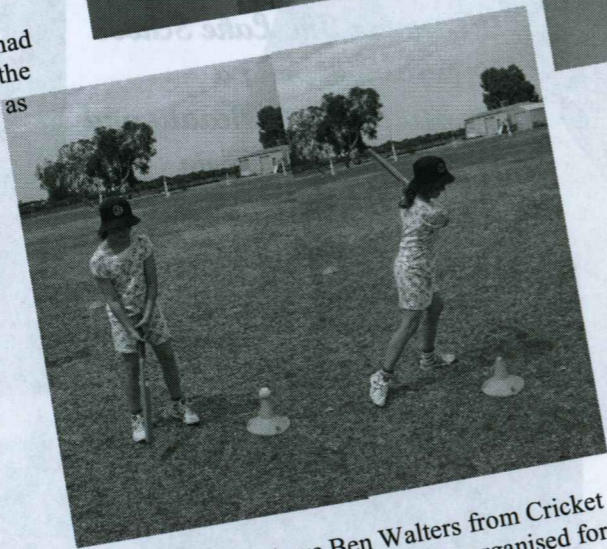
# Physical Education

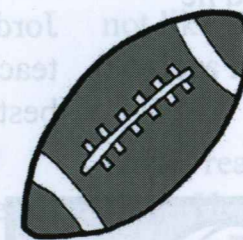
# Lightning Prems

# The Lake School Cross Country



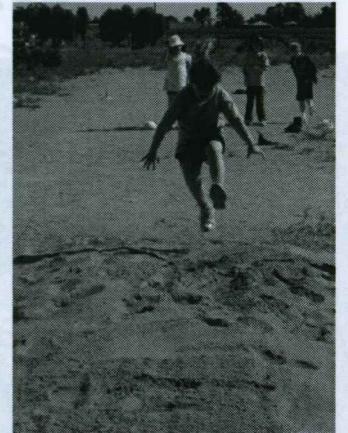

# Biggest Morning Tea



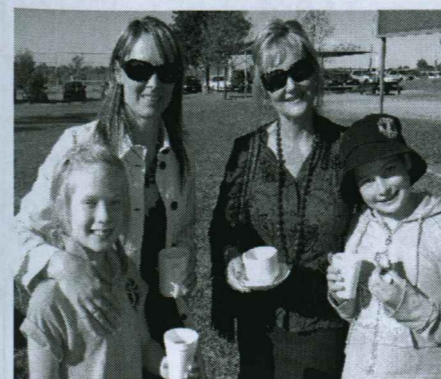
On Thursday the 24th of May The Lake Primary School held a biggest morning tea for parents and teachers, to support the Cancer Council. Even the children got a snack too!

16th of July, 2007, the day that The Lake School turned 99 years old.

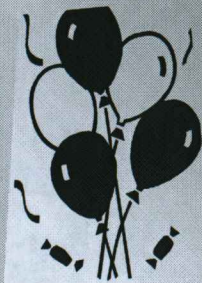
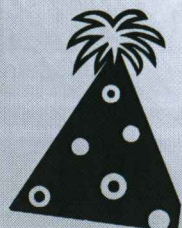

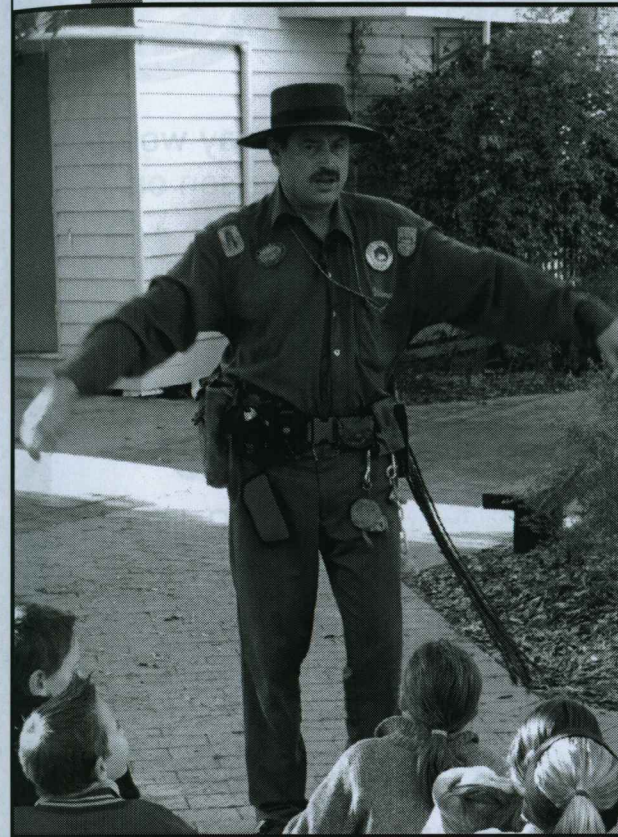

On Friday 8th June the school was very fortunate to host a visit from Philip Green, a naturalist calling himself 'Wildman'.

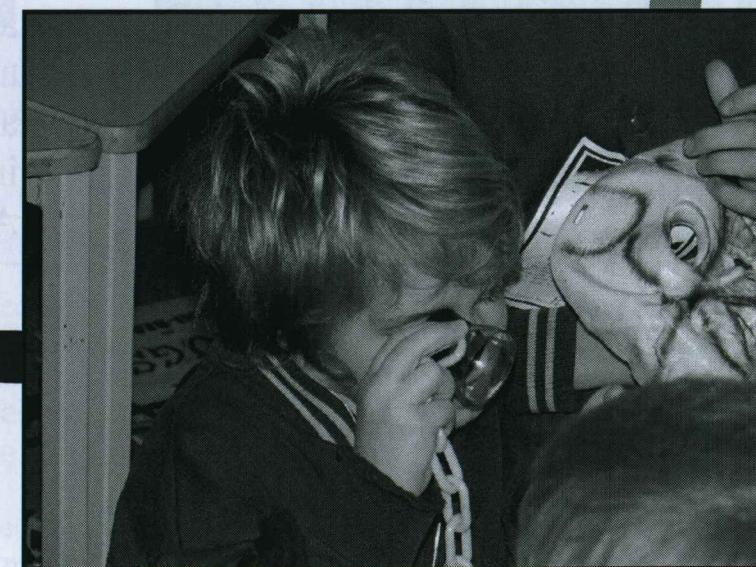
Wildman introduced The Lake School students to 'Ugly Bugs and Minibeasts'.

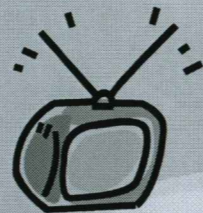

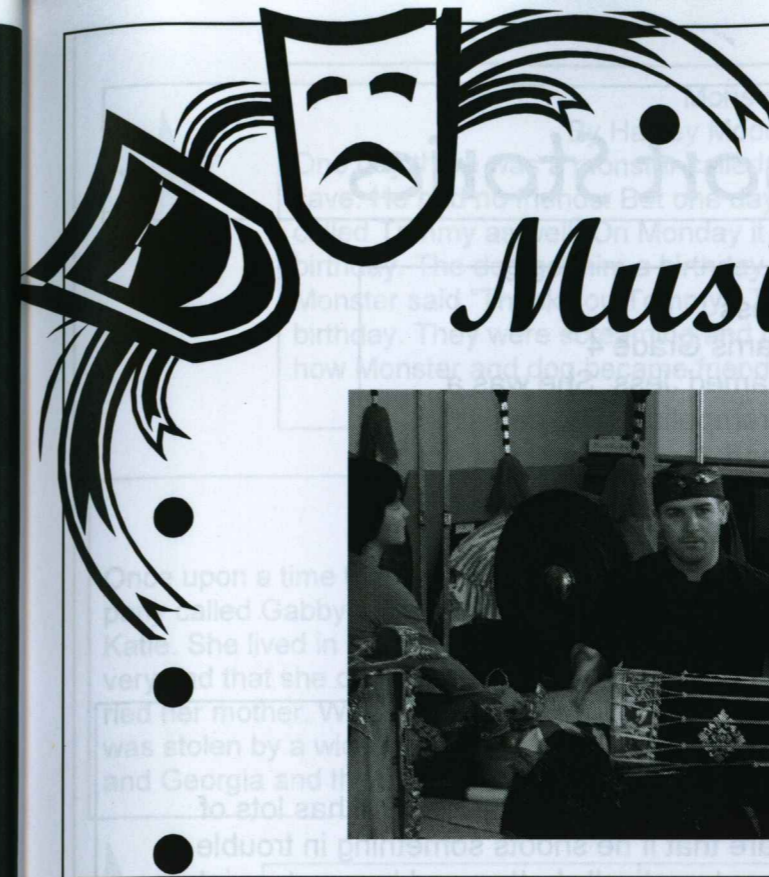

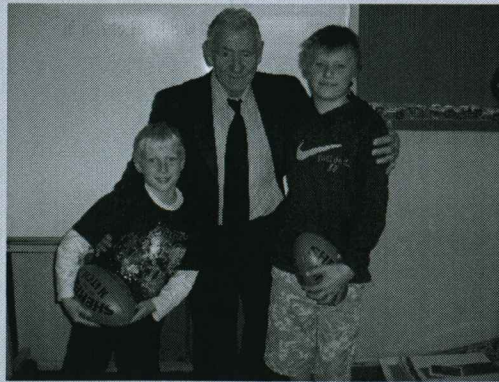
# Tommy Hafey Visit

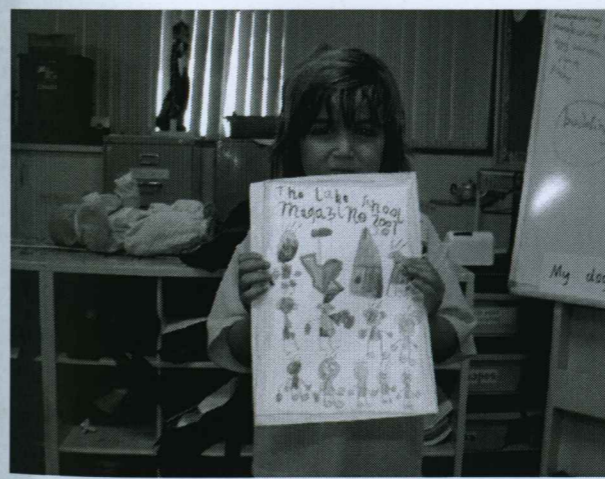

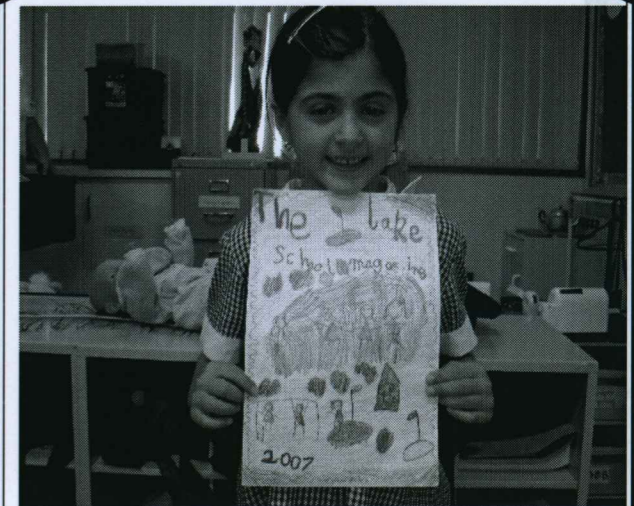
