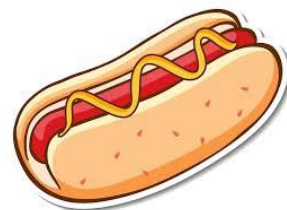
If you are able to assist on the day, it would be greatly appreciated. Please speak to the relevant staff at each event to see if they require any additional support on the day.
