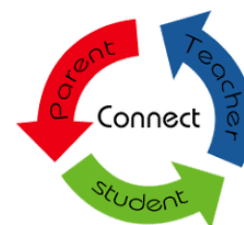
Prep Orientation Session – 2023 is looking bright!
