## Principal Message – Week 4

### Mosquitos

Due to the floods and excess water in our community, we have found lots of mosquitoes in our school environment. *“Mosquitoes aren't just a nuisance - they can transmit serious diseases. To protect yourself: cover-up with a loose-fitting long sleeved shirts and long pants when outside; apply mosquito repellent to exposed skin; take special care during peak mosquito biting hours, especially around dawn and dusk”.* (taken from [health.nsw.gov.au](http://health.nsw.gov.au))

Please ensure your child is protected by any of the following suggestions whilst at school-

- Spraying mosquito repellent before school (sprays not to be used at school)
- Purchasing mosquito patches, wristbands or roll-ons (available at chemists)
