

The closure of the Lake Hawthorn Caravan Park and the development of the land for housing have provided us with a fantastic view of Lake Hawthorn and we can now see clearly why we are called The Lake School.

During 2001 I took the opportunity to take long service leave and spent a wonderful month in sunny Queensland. I also used the break to shed some unwanted kilograms.

Mrs. McNair and Mrs. Sutherland also used part of the year to recuperate with long service leave and Ms Kerridge had a new baby. We were fortunate to have three great teachers to fill in during the teachers leave - Miss Newton, Mr. Byrne and Miss Allan.

As the year closes we can see a number of activities happening around the school. Our new classroom is almost complete, the front of the pavilion has been paved and a new water monitoring and imigation system has been installed in the block and on the oval.

Our school cooperative is being set up to develop a hard court facility for school and community use. We also had a great Christmas present with the granting of \$85 000 for new school toilets.

I would like to thank the staff and parents for their strong support of our school during 2001 and would like to especially thank the students for once again being a terrific bunch of kids - as our song goes "we are the kids from The Lake. and we're the best!"

I wish everyone a safe and happy Christmas and New Year and I look forward to a bigger and better 2002.

O. What do you think of The Lake Primary so far?


A.It's a fantastic small school, the kids are wonderful and the staff are very nice and they've made me welcome and happy to be here.







Steve My favourne song would have to be 'You and Me' by the Lake school kids.


Where do you live?





Q. When and where were you born?

Mr Mac: I was born in the Mildura Base Hospital on the 20th of April 1958.

Beading for the Blind

You are probably wondering what reading for the blind is. So were we when Mr Bell came in and asked who would like to read on the radio. Four people put their hands up. We had to go down to the other room. Melinda was there (she works for Vision Australia) we had to read two articles and a list of words. Only two people were able to read on the radio and they were Erica and Caitlin (me). Mr Bell chose Daniel. H to be the technical operator. The first time we went into the station was for practice and for Daniel to learn how to use everything that he needs to use. Erica and I had to learn how to fill out a Run Sheet. A run sheet is where you get a sheet and write down the name of your article, what page number, where you got the article from, what date was the newspaper and how long you think it would take to read. The day before we have to go in to read we have to get thirty minutes of articles and fill in the run sheet. The next day we go in to record. We go into the station. First we go into the recording room and record us reading. Then after we are finished reading we get up and have a stretch then sit back down and the same again and choose the best one to put on the air.
