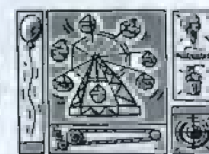
MILDURA SHOW EXCURSION

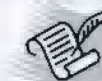

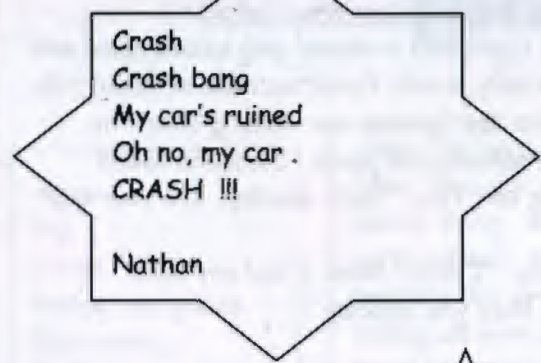

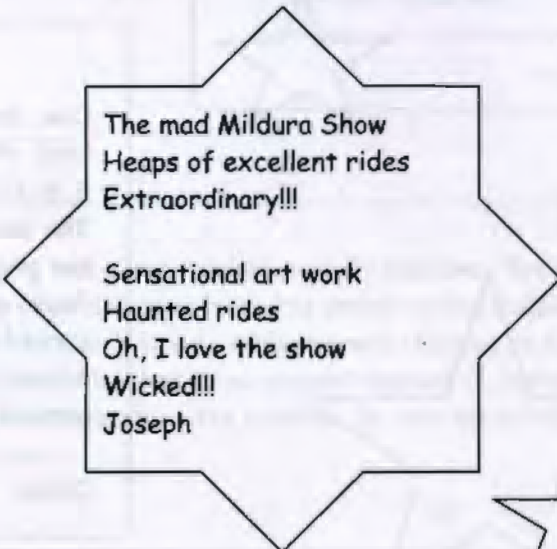
Life Cycle
