I would also like to thank our wonderful school office staff, Robyn and Sallie, for their support throughout the year.

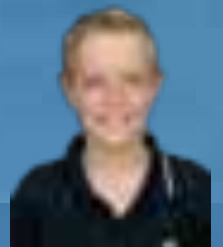

High-Ability Program

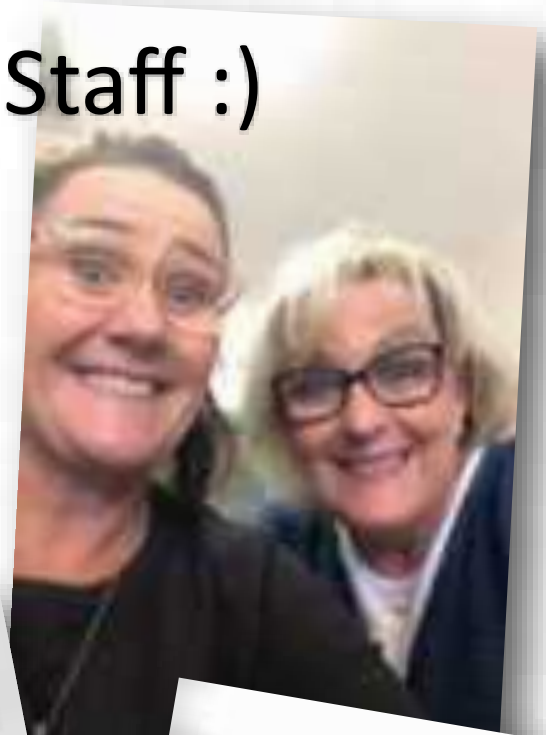
