#### Department of Education- Cyber Incident

A cyber incident that impacted some student data across all Victorian government schools.

## What has been accessed

A Department of Education database with current and past student information was accessed by an external third-party.

The third-party accessed active and inactive past school student accounts, consisting of:

- student name
- school-issued email address and encrypted password (for those that use them)
- school name
- year level

The third-party **did not access** other student data such as birth dates, home addresses or phone numbers.

## Your child's safety

The safety and wellbeing of students is our priority.

If you have safety concerns about your child's school location being known, please contact me and notify Victoria Police or The Orange Door as necessary.

## What's happened to the accessed data?

There is no evidence to suggest that the data accessed has been released publicly or shared with other third parties.

## Steps we are taking

All student passwords have been reset. All students will be issued a new password at the start of the school year.

The department has identified the cause of this incident and has put protections in place. They will continue to provide me with updates as we enter the 2026 school year.
